DOCTRINE OF HEATHENISM

- 1. What about the people who have never heard the Gospel.
- 2. The Gospel in every generation goes out throughout the world:
 Acts 17:6; *Colossians 1:6; I Timothy 3:16; Titus 2:11. Historical evidence bears this out.
- 3. Application of the doctrine of Divine Essence. Justice and +R means that it is impossible for God to be unfair or unjust to anyone.
- 4. Doctrine of Unlimited Atonement: (Show Overlay)

<u>1 Corinthians 5:14-15</u>-The love of Christ constraineth (motivates) us, because we thus judge (discern) that <u>if one died for all</u> (first class condition) then all were dead (spiritually), and that He died for all that they which live (spiritual birth) should no longer live unto themselves...

2 Corinthians 5:15, 15, *19, 1 Timothy 2:6, 4:10*, Titus 2:11

Hebrews 2:9, 2 Peter 2:1, 1 John 2:2

5. Application of God's Sovereignty: *2 Peter 3:9 Only negative volition at God

Consciousness or at Gospel hearing hinders salvation.

6. <u>God Consciousness</u> = Man becomes aware of the existence of God. *<u>PSALM 19:1-4</u>. Either one wants to know God or does not.

Gospel Hearing=Man receives gospel information. Volition-Either accepts the

gospel or not. <u>POINT:</u> If any person, no matter what his location on the planet, desires a relationship with God after reaching God Consciousness then God will

provide gospel information in order that that person may be saved.

Jeremiah 29:13; John 7:17; Acts 17:26-27.

<u>POINT:</u> People who do not reach God Consciousness are automatically saved at the point of death. 2 Samuel 12:23 "I shall go to Him but He Shall not return to me."

- 7. The principle of accountability: Mankind has the ability to arrive at God Consciousness through the activity of his own mind. *Romans 1:18-21 The point of accountability varies with age, culture, and environment. Psalm 19:1-4.
- 8. Five Mechanics of God Consciousness.
 - a. <u>Religious approach</u>-God must exist because people universally believe in God's existence. (Children hear people talk about God).
 - b. Moral or anthropological approach-Man has a conscience, if man has an urge to do right, there must be an absolute right. To a greater or lesser degree man possesses a conscience in his soul, which at times chooses right over wrong. A material ungoverned universe could know nothing of moral values or distinctions. This one is weak in our society today.
 - c. Ontological approach- The human mind conceives the concept of an infinite perfect being so such a being must exist.
 - d. <u>Teleological approach</u>-Design demands a designer. The structure of the universe demands a designer. <u>Romans 1:20</u>. Both telescopes and microscopes reveal order, design, and arrangement. An atom or galaxy demonstrate this.
 - e. <u>Cosmological approach</u>-The intuitive law of cause and effect demands the existence of God. For every cause there is an effect, intuitive thinking is thinking about the cause behind the effect.
- 9. Heathen are heathen because of their negative volition—not because they do not have a chance to be saved.
- Any person who is positive at God consciousness will receive the gospel so that he may be saved. (<u>JUST BELIEVING IN A SUPREME BEING WILL NOT CUT IT!</u> <u>JOHN 14:56</u>- "I AM THE WAY..." JOHN 3:36-HE WHO BELIEVES IN THE SON HAS LIFE, BUT HE WHO DOES NOT BELIEVE SHALL NOT SEE LIFE.
- 11. People who are positive at God Consciousness receive the Gospel. Jeremiah 29:13; Acts 17:26-27, *John 7:1-17.
