Imputed +R or Experiential +R

What do these terms mean?

But My righteous one shall live by faith

shall live . . . ZAOMAI (ζαομαι) v. fmi

The middle voice means the subject of the verb is affected by its own action or is acting upon itself.

But My righteous one shall live by faith

by faith . . . EK PISTIS (εκ πιστις) n. gsf

**This genitive emphasizes what is believed;
in this case, it would be doctrine.**

***But My righteous one shall live
by means of doctrine.***

***2 Cor. 5:7 . . . for we walk by faith, Bible
doctrine, not by sight . . .***

Heb. 10:38 . . . “shrinking back”
