
The Gift of Salvation is received



John 3:18, He who believes in Him is not judged;



EUAGGELION (ευαγγελιον)

EU = good

AGGELLIO = to proclaim or tell, news.

EUAGGELION good news - gospel

EULOGIO good word - praise, blessed

EUCCHARIST good grace - Communion,
Lord's Supper
